This program is for high school seniors who want **an introduction to Ohio State with a special focus on our selective Scholars Programs**. Students targeted for the Ohio State Scholars Program are typically in the top 20 percent of their class, with ACT test scores of 27 or higher, and not eligible for the Honors Program. If you are looking for a small and unique community to enhance your university life, Scholars Programs are a great place to start.

**Highlights:** Attend a Scholars Fair and meet the coordinators of the 14 Scholars programs; find out about the benefits and opportunities of our learning communities—particularly the Scholars programs; and explore campus to learn about what everyday life is like for a student at Ohio State.
